They operate off grid thanks to a vast solar array and battery setup, employ innovative land management practices, building soil health and reduce water use by applying straw mulch undervine. 1970 The property was fully planted with vines. Grape growing became the Hahn family way of life and six generations later, James and Jackie Hahn continued that legacy, living and working on the land originally purchased by Christian Hahn.

1997 The Hahns decided to produce their own range of red wines and teamed up with Barossa winemaker, Rolf Binder for the winemaking. The JJ Hahn label was born.

2010 The Hahns retired from the business and Rolf Binder retained co-ownership of the brand, winemaking and vineyard management.

2023 Rolf has handed over the reigns to Thomas White (who has made the wines since 2021) to run the business with Rolf overseeing the vintage winemaking and blending of the wines.

BLOCK 6 SHIRAZ

Planted in 1892, Block 6 Shiraz is a cornerstone of Kay Brothers' legacy, producing full-bodied wines with the grace to age for decades. The 1.5-hectare vineyard thrives on diverse soils—red loam, heavy clay, and gravelly alluvium—underpinned by the complex "South Maslin Sands" geology. Its vines are cane-pruned and carefully maintained to suit the vineyard's natural undulations and east-facing aspect.

To preserve these venerable vines, the team employs Layering, a technique where new vines are grown from neighbouring "mother vines" via an "umbilical cord," which naturally decays over time. Winter brings the art of hand-pruning each vine to its unique growth habits, while spring shoot thinning ensures concentrated fruit. Every grape is hand-picked to protect the fragile, century-old vines.

Fermented in the original open-top fermenters, Block 6 Shiraz showcases deep complexity, vibrant intensity, and a timeless connection to Kay Brothers' rich winemaking heritage.

Installed in 1928 vintage to replace older hydraulic and manual screw presses that were unreliable. For winemaker Duncan, it is still the preferred of their two presses. The basket press reflects Kay Brothers traditional winemaking philosophy. The grapes are pressed gently, resulting in softer tannins and cleaner juice – as the juice is filtered through the mass of pulp while draining through the basket. Whilst this process is labour intensive and time consuming, Kay Brothers are confident it translates to superior quality.

LAKE BREEZE WINERY

Lake Breeze Winery is nestled on the banks of the Bremer River, surrounded by majestic river red gums and overlooking the sprawling 90-hectare Follett family vineyard. Managed by Tim Follett, the vineyards produce consistently exceptional fruit, which winemaker Greg Follett uses to craft outstanding wines.

FLOODING SYSTEM

The old vines at Lake Breeze are dry-grown, relying on the traditional winter flooding of the Bremer River, which originates from rainfall in the Mount Lofty Ranges. This natural flooding is essential for sustaining the vines through Langhorne Creek's dry summers, where annual rainfall averages just 350mm.

Flooding is managed using a system of floodgates and banks that channel the river's winter flow onto the vineyards. The water saturates the soil over one to two days before being released to neighbouring properties. This process deposits nutrient-rich silt, maintaining soil fertility and enhancing the water-holding capacity of the alluvial silty loam, ensuring the vines thrive without supplementary irrigation.

LANGHORNE CREEK CLIMATE

There is a cool maritime climate with a mean January temperature of 19.9°C and 1520 heat degree days. It is significantly cooler than McLaren Vale (21.7°C, 1910 HDD) and the Barossa (21.4°C, 1710 HDD). This is partly due to the "Lake Doctor", a southerly wind coming off Lake Alexandrina at the end of the Murray Darling River system. The wind carries its cooling effect across the lake directly from the Antarctic and the Southern ocean. The influence it has on the climate is dramatic; it moderates summer heat and mitigates winter frosts. Langhorne Creek's fertile soils are predominantly deep, alluvial sandy loams, perfect for enhancing vine vigour and growing high quality red varieties.

THE REGION

The Pyrenees Wine Region is one of Australia's finest wine regions. Often underrated, the wines are intensely flavoured and carry the hallmarks of individuality and character. The wineries are understated, small and publicity shy, possibly a reason for the region flying under the radar for almost 50 years. Arguably one of Victoria's best kept secrets, the natural beauty of the region is only surpassed by its incredible wines.

THE ORGANIC JOURNEY

In the 1990s, the winery began to use native Australian insects to attack caterpillars and has since made use of other natural pesticides while avoiding fungicides. Becoming a fully certified organic winery was the natural next step. Following a tasting of organic and biodynamic from all over the world, Matthew realised that going organic was a way to ensure that our wines had a vitality and pep that would stand them apart from the majority of wines on the market. So, Mount Avoca took the dirt path less travelled and treated the vineyard like a garden, doggedly pursuing that elusive purity flavour and vivaciousness.

This search for quality led to a completely natural and chemical-free philosophy. The organic certification is really a by-product of growing the best-quality fruit. As Matthew says, 'Our holy grail was always totally amazing wines with a purity of flavour and no chemical residue. The certification was a happy side effect.'

THE PEOPLE

Founded in 1970 by John and Arda Barry, Mount Avoca is now run by Matthew Barry and sons, who are proudly carrying on the family tradition. Winemaker David Darlow has over 20 years of winemaking experience in Europe, the US, New Zealand and across Australia. His background as a fine wine retailer and chef extraordinaire adds the broad brushstrokes to his mastery of detail in all aspects of viticulture and winemaking.

PAPER MACHE

Much like the art of papier-mâché, which transforms humble materials into something unique, Paper Mache wines evolve in appearance, texture, and character through the use of natural resources. Each wine reflects the creativity, craftsmanship, and collective effort behind its creation.

SAUVIGNON BLANC

While the Riverland is not typically associated with Sauvignon Blanc, a careful understanding of how to preserve its green, grassy characters (methoxyprazine) makes it possible to craft a wine that reflects a cooler climate. Methoxyprazine levels decrease as fruit ripens or when temperatures rise within the canopy, so for the 2024 Paper Mache Sauvignon Blanc, the grapes were harvested early at lower sugar levels, before heat could affect the fruit's fresh character. Light in colour and shows a balance of grassy and tropical flavours. The palate is clean, balanced with a nice acid zing.

LIGHT RED

This unique blend of Tempranillo, Shiraz, and Black Muscat, all sourced from the Riverland, combines familiar elements with a rare twist. While Tempranillo and Shiraz are often found in light red blends, the inclusion of Black Muscat imparts distinctive floral aromas that elevate the wine's fragrance. Fermented in stainless steel to preserve freshness, the goal was to create a zippy, versatile wine that can be enjoyed chilled. The result is a light cherry-coloured wine with negromi and cola aromatics. The absence of harsh tannins allow this wine to be enjoyed at both room and chilled temperature.

SHIRAZ

This blend of Wrattenbully and Riverland Shiraz showcases the distinct expressions of Shiraz from each region. Wrattenbully contributes concentrated, dense flavours, while the Riverland adds confectionary and spice notes, creating a perfect balance between the two. Aromas of white pepper and chocolate. On the palate, it is rich, powerful, and well-balanced, offering impressive length and depth.

THE PETER LEHMANN STORY

The late 1970s were difficult times for the Barossa wine grape growing community as the region was hit with a severe grape surplus. Companies refused to buy grapes and honour contracts, and Peter Lehmann knew this would destroy the livelihoods of the 140 family growers.

In a courageous bid to support his community of growers, Peter took out a loan, assembled equipment and built a small winery to process their grapes. The winery was called Masterson of the Barossa, in a nod to the famous gambler, Skye Masterson from the musical, Guys and Dolls.

The wine from the first vintage in 1980 was called 'The Futures' in a nod to the commitment Peter made to paying the growers once he had sold the wine. This arrangement was sealed with a handshake and Peter's word was his bond. True to his promise, when the money started coming in Peter made sure to pay his growers first.

Led by Peter, the Barossa community pulled together during the tough times, not just to make great wine but to preserve the future of the land and the Barossa region. Today these longstanding relationships with the same community of family growers gives the Peter Lehmann winemakers unrivalled access to the very best grapes across the length and breadth of the Barossa.

Although Peter is no longer with us, his legend lives on through Peter Lehmann Wines.

The vision to evolve a traditionally planted vineyard into one that could adapt to extreme climatic changes goes beyond grape variety selection. The adoption of drought tolerant rootstocks, water saving mulches and new viticultural techniques and technology allow Ricca Terra to grow grapes and make premium wine with minimal inputs and a limited environmental footprint. Today, Ricca Terra's spread of vineyards is in excess of 70Ha. They have over 30 different varieties planted and are one of the largest producers of climate adaptive grape varieties in South Australia.

Ashley Ratcliff has always been passionate about the wine industry. His vision to create a sustainable future for Ricca Terra has resulted in him winning many accolades including Innovative Vineyard of the Year (Young Guns of Wine) Gourmet Traveller Viticulturist of the Year, Riverland Winemaker of the Year & Best Wineries of the Region by James Halliday.

The 'Soldier's Land' range is a project close to Ashley's heart. These wines are made from vineyards established during the Soldiers Settlement Scheme post WW1 & WW2. He has saved these ancient vines and donated a portion of proceeds from the sale of these wines to the RSL.

Springs Road runs east to west across the northern part of KI with the vineyard established in 1994 on a small sheep farm about 7km west of Kingscote. In 2016 Joch Bosworth and Louise Hemsley-Smith from McLaren Vale's organic Battle of Bosworth wines purchased the vineyards, opening a cellar door and releasing their first KI wines under the Springs Road label at the end of 2018. The wines are hand-made and estate grown. The Springs Road label is adapted from Louis Freycinet's 1808 map of Southern Australia 'Terre Napoleon'.

KANGAROO ISLAND Is one of the five regions that make up the Fleurieu Zone and was officially registered as a wine region by Geographic Indication in the year 2000. It is a cool-climate region with regular maritime breezes playing an important role in moderating the ample sunshine and allowing for a long, cool ripening season. The vineyard is on a special site in a very special place. It has a unique combination of relatively low rainfall, low soil fertility and a moderate maritime climate which results in low yielding vines producing highly coloured and intensely flavoured wines.

A bright fresh sparkling red with a hint of aniseed on the nose, cherry cola and a fine bead. The palate has a lovely complexity borne of the slightly older components of Cabernet and Shiraz which form the basis of this wine.

CHARDONNAY

This 2024 Chardonnay is fermented in barrel and is a delicious full-bodied (but not buttery) Chardonnay showing cashew and white stone fruit on the nose and palate, with a hint of nougat too. A super balanced wine with lovely oak, acid, fruit and length.

LITTLE ISLAND RED

'little island red' is a bright, fresh lightly oaked Shiraz showing red fruits (raspberry, cherry, black cherry) and dark fruits, along with black pepper and an overall pretty floral character. Bright, fresh, medium-weight, fine and with a great length.

TIM ADAMS' began during a grape shortage in 1986, relying on 10 tonnes of Shiraz from a neighbour to release its first wine under the Adams and Wray label. Following the dissolution of the partnership in 1987, the winery was renamed Tim Adams Wines, coinciding with the purchase of its Warenda Road site in Clare and the arrival of Tim's daughter, Frances. By 1988, the cellar door was opened, and the first grapes were crushed on-site, marking the start of decades of growth, evolution, and commitment to sustainability and the Australian wine community. Tim Adams, raised in Clare Valley, began his career in 1975 under the mentorship of the renowned Mick Knappstein at the Stanley Wine Company, eventually releasing his first wines under his own label in 1986. Their relationship, with Mr Mick as Tim's last apprentice, continued until his passing in 1997, leaving a legacy of passion, hard work, and dedication that defines the progressive family winery today.

ABERFELDY SHIRAZ

The Aberfeldy Shiraz is the flagship wine of Tim Adams Wines and has long been synonymous with quality, often referred to as "Clare Valley's Grange." Crafted from century-old, low-yielding Shiraz vines in the warmer eastern reaches of Clare Valley, it exemplifies elegance, intensity, and the region's terroir. This iconic Australian Shiraz delivers a rich palate of dark fruits, chocolate, and spice, with velvety tannins and exceptional structure, making it ideal for long-term cellaring. Consistently earning Gold medals at the International Wine Challenge and maintaining a Langton's Classification, the Aberfeldy Shiraz represents the pinnacle of Clare Valley winemaking and the unwavering dedication of Tim Adams Wines to producing world-class wines.

SINGLE VINEYARD

Each wine in the Single Vineyard collection is a lens into the diverse and distinctive sub-regions of Clare Valley. By focusing on individual sites, the range captures the subtle interplay of soil, slope, climate, and vine age. These factors shape aroma, texture, and flavour in profound ways. These wines are not blended to homogenise a style; rather, they are celebrated for their singularity. It's a vineyard-first approach that speaks directly to wine lovers seeking authenticity, origin, and a tangible connection to place.

CLARE VALLEY has a history rich in wine with the first vineyards planted in the early 1840's. Located inland, 2 hours north of Adelaide, the long warm summer days are moderated by cooling afternoon breezes. This creates a large diurnal range perfect for ripening Riesling and Shiraz with full flavour while also retaining fresh acidity. Eleven soil types including Polish Hill's broken slate and Watervales limestone sub-soils have made this region highly regarded for producing outstanding Riesling. Young Clare Riesling shows fresh citrus fruits and apple with great depth of flavour and natural acidity. They also age beautifully, developing nutty, toasty and honey notes. To showcase aged Riesling the Tim Adams range includes a 2019 museum release.

2021 Ladera Tempranillo- 93 Points

"The vines for this wine were planted in 2004 and are dry grown. This delivers the goods. Scents of ripe cherry, cola, cranberry, dark chocolate, salted licorice. The palate leans into sarsaparilla, fennel, rosemary herbal lift and a bit of dark chocolate. Texture is informed by quite a bit of concentration and richness, feels quite juicy but a sheath of dusty tannin does a good job of compacting things. Nicely played."

ZONTE'S FOOTSTEPS NAME

On 15 August 2003, Zonte's Footstep vintaged its first wines and, as is tradition in the wine industry, looked to history—and prehistory—for its name. In 1893, a vineyard was planted with Zante currants to produce table grapes for Adelaide's growing population. By the 1920s, the vineyard was replanted with wine-producing varieties of Shiraz and Cabernet Sauvignon, which were eventually used to craft Zonte's first wine. As a tribute to the vineyard's journey (and due to naming regulations that prevent referencing grape varieties not in the wine), the "A" in Zante was changed to an "O," creating Zonte's. In 1999, a group of wine industry mates purchased the vineyard, planting Viognier, Sangiovese, and other exciting grape varieties to experiment with. While replanting, large boulders with fossilised footprints of the Diprotodon, the largest known marsupial, were discovered. This unique fossilised footprint cemented the name and symbolised the journey Zonte's Footstep continues today.



OUR STORY

Domaine Thomson began in 2000 when David and PM Hall-Jones purchased their block in Central Otago, naming it after David's great-great-grandfather, "Surveyor Thomson," who explored and mapped the region in the 1850s. Inspired by their love of Burgundy, they immediately began planting Pinot Noir with a mixture of Davis and Dijon clones.

THE VINEYARD

At 45° South, the estate sits high above the valley floor with 360-degree views of the Cromwell Basin and Lake Dunstan, framed by the Pisa, Dunstan and St Bathans ranges. The 14-hectare vineyard is planted as four distinct blocks – the North Block, the Terraces, the South Block and the Moon Block – each with its own character. The elevated north-east facing slopes of deep gravel, loess and clay, together with a relatively frost-free mesoclimate, create ideal growing conditions that deliver Pinot Noir with concentration, intensity and finesse.

Under the guidance of Vineyard Manager Simon Gourley, the vines are farmed organically and biodynamically, certified with BioGro since 2014. Much of the work is carried out by hand, including harvesting to preserve fruit integrity. Renowned winemaker Dean Shaw has crafted Domaine Thomson wines since the first release of Surveyor Thomson Pinot Noir in 2003, continuing the vision of terroir-driven Central Otago wines of purity and elegance.

EDMOND THERY

Edmond Thery was a French economist and sparkling wine lover. He decided to spend the majority of his time in wine production (Late 1800's). To ensure the highest quality possible, the cellar has been dug ten meters underground and it became the reference in the region. SUSTAINABLE VITICULTURE

Forget-Brimont adopted a sustainable viticulture and minimal-intervention method 20 years ago. A non-interventionist winemaking approach has been adopted to allow full expression of the terroirs and varieties. Only the first press (la cuvée) is used and only the best of that pressing is kept, adhering to the commitment to quality and purity.

Blending with a high proportion (40% to 50%) of reserve wines of almost 10 different years in each cuvée, except Vintages, adds depth and complexity. The Champagnes then undergo a lengthy secondary fermentation 15m underground in traditional chalk cellars for between 30 months & 10 years. The wines don't contain additives, aren't fined and are matured on lees in thermoregulated tanks before bottling. After dosage they receive an additional 2 to 6 months bottle age before release.

CÔTES DU RHÔNE

The Dupond family has a long and respected history in the wine industry, with roots in Burgundy and the Rhône Valley. In 1880, Joanny Dupond expanded the family's vineyards from Beaujolais to the Côtes du Rhône by founding the La Renjardière vineyard just north of Châteauneuf-du-Pape. Among the estate's offerings, the La Renjardière Côtes du Rhône Rouge stands out. Lovingly nicknamed "The Red Stripe of Côtes du Rhône" for its distinctive label, this wine has been a favorite since its label design was introduced in 1960 and continues to thrive today.

HISTORY

PERNAND-VERGELESSES

Sitting at the northern end of the Côte de Beaune and is one of the most picturesque villages in Burgundy. Pleasant aromas of honey and honeysuckle evolve into exotic notes. A wine of character, energy and mineral notes. An intense, fruity and fresh aftertaste.

MEURSAULT

Sitting directly north of Montrachet and producing mostly Chardonnay. The wines show almond, hazelnut, floral and mineral notes. Butter, honey and citrus, rich and fat on the palate they benefit from aging. The best soils of Jurassic marls and marly limestones are found at 260m

BEAUNE

The southern end of the Côte d'Or, named after the historical town and wine centre of Beaune. Predominantly producing Pinot Noir, the wines are known for being a good 'middle-ground' between the rich, masculine style of Pommard to the south and the highly structured wines of Corton to the north.

CHAMBOLLE-MUSIGNY

A beautiful small commune in central Côte de Nuits renowned for making powerful, feminine, refined and very aromatic Pinot Noirs. The vineyards lie on three sides of the village, on the slopes next to and starting at an altitude of 300m. The best vineyards are on the fine, well-drained soils of the mid-slope. The climate in Chambolle-Musigny, as throughout the wider Côte d'Or, is continental. Diurnal temperature variation helps to establish balanced acids and sugars in the wines.

BURGUNDY, FRANCE / EST. 2014

POMMARD

Situated between Volnay to the South and Beaune to the North. Pommard is on a slope, between - 240 and 380 metres, facing east and south-east. The clay-rich calcareous soil gives Pommard some quite unique qualities - a lot of colour (deep red black), and an intense bouquet of blackcurrants, musk and game meat.

VOLNAY

Nestled between Pommard and Meursault in Côte de Beaune, Volnay is renowned for producing long lived, smooth, perfumed, delicate Pinot Noir with a supple structure quite contrasting to its more powerful neighbours. The best vineyards are located in a tight band across the mid slope where the vines benefit from well drained, limestone soils and a southeastern aspect.

GEVREY-CHAMBERTIN

The most northern of the great communes of the Côte de Nuits. There are 26 Premiers Crus and 8 Grands Crus. Arnaud Baillot Gevrey-Chambertin wines are produced from vineyards lying on the extension of the slope on which the Grands and Premiers Crus are situated.

ECHÉZEAUX

A Grand Cru vineyard on the slopes above the village of Flagey-Echézeaux, just north of the famous vineyards of Vosne-Romanée. The upper-mid slopes are generally recognised as being the climat's best patches because of the stonier, thinner soils and good drainage. Made exclusively from Pinot Noir, the wines are on the full-bodied end of the Burgundy spectrum, showing red fruit as well as spice and undergrowth characters.



ARNAUD BAILLOT

Arnaud Baillot produce a spectacular range of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay from some of the best appellations in Burgundy. Their recently completed state of the art winery is located in Beaune, the heart of the Côte d'Or. Owner and winemaker Arnaud is passionate about the diversity of wines the Burgundy region has to offer. He has teamed up with his wife Laure (granddaughter of Alain Noëllat of the famed Domaine Hudelot-Noëllat) to make small parcels of wine originating from select Village, Premier Cru and Grand Cru vineyards.



The wines are always on the fresh side, with ripe acidity, and that classic Chablis minerality. The appellation of Chablis is nestled in the Northern part of Burgundy between Paris and Dijon. It has a semi-continental climate, characterised by hot summers and cold, harsh winters. The wines are characterised by purity of fruit and lean, steely acidity. Chablis is divided into four categories in order of ascension in quality: Petit Chablis, Chablis, Chablis Premier Cru and Chablis Grand Cru.



LANGHE

AGLIANICO

The late ripening Aglianico, arguably the most exceptional variety grown in Irpinia, produces a rustic, earth driven, full bodied red with distinctive savory flavours of leather, white pepper, black fruits and cured meats. It has high tannins, high acidity and an aging potential of 20+ years. The most famous Aglianico is from Taurasi DOCG, grown in the volcanic hills of Avellino directly inland from Naples. RADICI TAURASI

Obtained by the union of precious selections of Aglianico grapes from the estates of Montemarano and Mirabella Eclano, the symbol product of classical viticulture signed Mastroberardino. Montemarano, with its 16 hectares, is a historic site in the production of Taurasi, located in the further south and higher area of the DOCG, from 500 to 650 metres above sea level.

Here the marked temperature ranges and the slower trend of maturation set the conditions for a late harvest, usually in November, resulting in grapes richer in noble tannins and acidity, able to enhance the longevity characters. Mirabella Eclano, with more than 65 hectares and with an altitude ranging from 350 to 450 meters ASL, is the core of production, research and experimentation on Aglianico, which is the main grape variety grown in this estate.

VALPANTENA

The roots of La Collina dei Ciliegi lie in the heart of Valpantena, specifically in Erbin, a quaint village of Cimbrian origin nestled among rolling hills. This picturesque region is surrounded by vineyards, cherry trees, meadows, and magnificent woods.

The Valpantena Valley, with its pre-Alpine alluvial origins, boasts calcareous-clayey soils. During summer, the area is cooled by refreshing air currents from the Dolomites, leading to significant temperature fluctuations, especially at higher altitudes.

In their vineyards, the highest in the entire Valpantena, grape ripening is delayed by up to a month compared to the valley bottom, aiding the development of unique aromas and fragrances.
